Products include limited transferable features. The Legacy Remodeling "No Service Charge" feature of the CENTURY WARRANTY assures the Customer will receive the Industry's most comprehensive workmanship warranty.

REGISTRATION: No registration is required. Upon installation of your products, your product warranty is in full effect. The Product Manufacturer's warranty is available upon request.

TRANSFER OF WARRANTY: All Products offered by Legacy Remodeling permit the customer to transfer this Century Warranty to a subsequent owner. The warranty period extended to the new owner is determined by the specific product purchased. The original customer must notify Legacy of the date of the property sale and the new homeowner's name within 30 days of the sale date.

ENTRY DOORS AND STORM DOORS: The doors that Legacy Remodeling install offer a Lifetime Limited Transferable Warranty. Doors are warranted to not shrink, warp, split, crack or delaminate for as long as you own your home. If the products are determined by the product manufacturer to be defective, they will be repaired or replaced at no charge to the customer.

WINDOW CONDENSATION FACTS AND TIPS

This warranty does not extend to normal homeowner maintenance of products installed by Legacy Remodeling. Normal homeowner maintenance includes but is not limited to; such items as re-caulking, re-nailing, re-sealing, adjusting, cleaning, etc. Furthermore; damage caused by fire, lightning, tornadoes, floods, other acts of God, civil disorder, vandalism, alteration, war or unreasonable use, abuse, misuse, structural settlements, chemicals and failure to follow instructions are not covered.

Legacy Remodeling reserves the right to inspect any warranty or service claims to assure that this warranty applies.

Legacy Remodeling reserves the right to change, discontinue or alter any of its products or parts at its sole discretion without notice. Should a product require replacement due to a warranty claim, a product of equal or better value will be supplied at the sole option of the manufacturer as outlined in the manufacturer's warranty.

Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts or the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above exclusions or limitations may not apply to you. This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

Do not leave small children unattended when windows are open or unlocked; screens are easily removable from the inside and are not designed as a safety restraint.

Condensation on your glass surface is not a warranty claim. It is a normal process that can be controlled by the homeowner.

Is your glass "sweating" or is water beading or ice forming on the inside surface of your windows? There's a good chance that what you are seeing is condensation, a sign that there's excess humidity in your home.

THE CAUSE: Indoor moisture is caused by a variety of factors, including cooking, showering, running dishwashers, storing firewood, pets, fish tanks, plants, clothes dryers, furnace humidifiers and even breathing.

Simply put, when warm moist air comes in contact with a cold surface, condensation has an opportunity to form on the surface. The higher the humidity level in your home, the more likely you may experience condensation on your window or door products. The humidity level that should be maintained in your home varies with the outside temperature. The colder it is outside, the lower the humidity level should be inside your home. The following is a guideline to follow:

Outside Temp	Relative Humidity
-20 Degrees	15% or Less
-10 Degrees	15% to 20%
0 Degrees	20% to 25%
+10 Degrees	25% to 30%
+20 Degrees	30% to 35%

If there is moisture **between** the glass surfaces, you have a seal failure.
